

## **PETITION FROM THE RESIDENTS OF BOYER STREET**

Report of the Director of Housing and Customer Service

### **1. SUMMARY**

A petition was received at the Stockbrook Street Housing Office on the 21 July 2010 from residents living on the Boyer Street sheltered housing scheme. The residents were complaining about dog fouling on the grassed area around the complex.

### **2. RECOMMENDATION**

That the Local Housing Board South notes the report and action taken by the Stockbrook Street Housing Manager to resolve the issue.

### **3. MATTER FOR CONSIDERATION**

- 3.1 Nine residents on the Boyer Street scheme were complaining about another resident who was allowing her dog to foul on the grass around the complex.
- 3.2 The Housing Manager visited the resident concerned and advised her that she must be more considerate and ensure that she removes any mess that her dog leaves behind.
- 3.3 Since this discussion with the resident, a Housing Officer has been checking the grassed areas around Boyer Street every week and seen no sign of dog excrement. Residents have been asked to contact the Local Housing Office if they witness any further problems. The petitioners have been advised.
