

The path to the entrance is used as a short cut for people visiting the nearby shops and residents have had issues with people knocking on windows as they walk past. Children also ride their bikes along this path and down the steps at the end of the path. Residents are concerned that elderly residents might get knocked over when exiting the flats. Thirty nine consultation letters were sent and twenty two residents responded in favour of the work. This application has been approved at the Housing Focus Group
6	Maple Drive car park, Chellaston	Dig out grassed area, tarmac and white line to make an additional car parking space. Relocate a sign and dig out and tamac a small area adjacent to 43 Maple Drive.	The local residents have complaint about the poor state of the car park. The car park is a small car park, with limited amount of parking spaces and it is difficult to manoeuvre the vehicles in and out the car park without churning up the grass. 7	Exeter House	To supply and install lockable metal folding gates (approx 1.8m x 4m) around the bicycle shed at Exeter House.	In April 2012, a bicycle shed was installed at Exeter House funded by Estates Pride. There has been a spate of bicycle thefts in the last six months. Residents have complained that there is no security in or around the bicycle shelter and this has made them more susceptible to theft. The new gates will stop these thefts from occurring.	SW	£3,700.00	This application has been posted on facebook and Derby Homes website. Forty consultation letters were sent and twenty residents responded in favour of the work. This application has been approved at the Housing Focus Group
8	Sporting Futures, Sinfin	To deliver one free sports session a week for children living in Sinfin.	To provide sporting activities for children living in the Sinfin area. In particular this anti social behaviour includes breaking glass in windows and doors and drinking alcohol in the tenant's garden. The new fencing will resolve this anti social behaviour.
