We surveyed Derby Homes customers living near Tintagel Community Space and people accessing the activities, to gather their views on the plans. These are captured in this report.








Q2 Do you use the facilities at Tintagel Close Common Room and Community Space?








Q3 Do you pay the Common Room Service Charge as part of your rent with Derby Homes?
