- 3.1 In September 2005, a report outlining Derby Homes' IIP Action Plan was presented to Resources Committee.
- 3.2 The IIP Action Plan has been fully implemented.
- 3.3 An IIP review took place on 26 May 2006.
- 3.4 The review concluded that Derby Homes met the IIP standard in full. Derby Homes has therefore retained IIP recognition for a further three years.
