### **1. SUMMARY OF REPORT**

3.1 In September 2005, a report outlining Derby Homes' IIP Action Plan was presented to Resources Committee.

3.2 The IIP Action Plan has been fully implemented.

3.3 An IIP review took place on 26 May 2006.

3.4 The review concluded that Derby Homes met the IIP standard in full. Derby Homes has therefore retained IIP recognition for a further three years.
