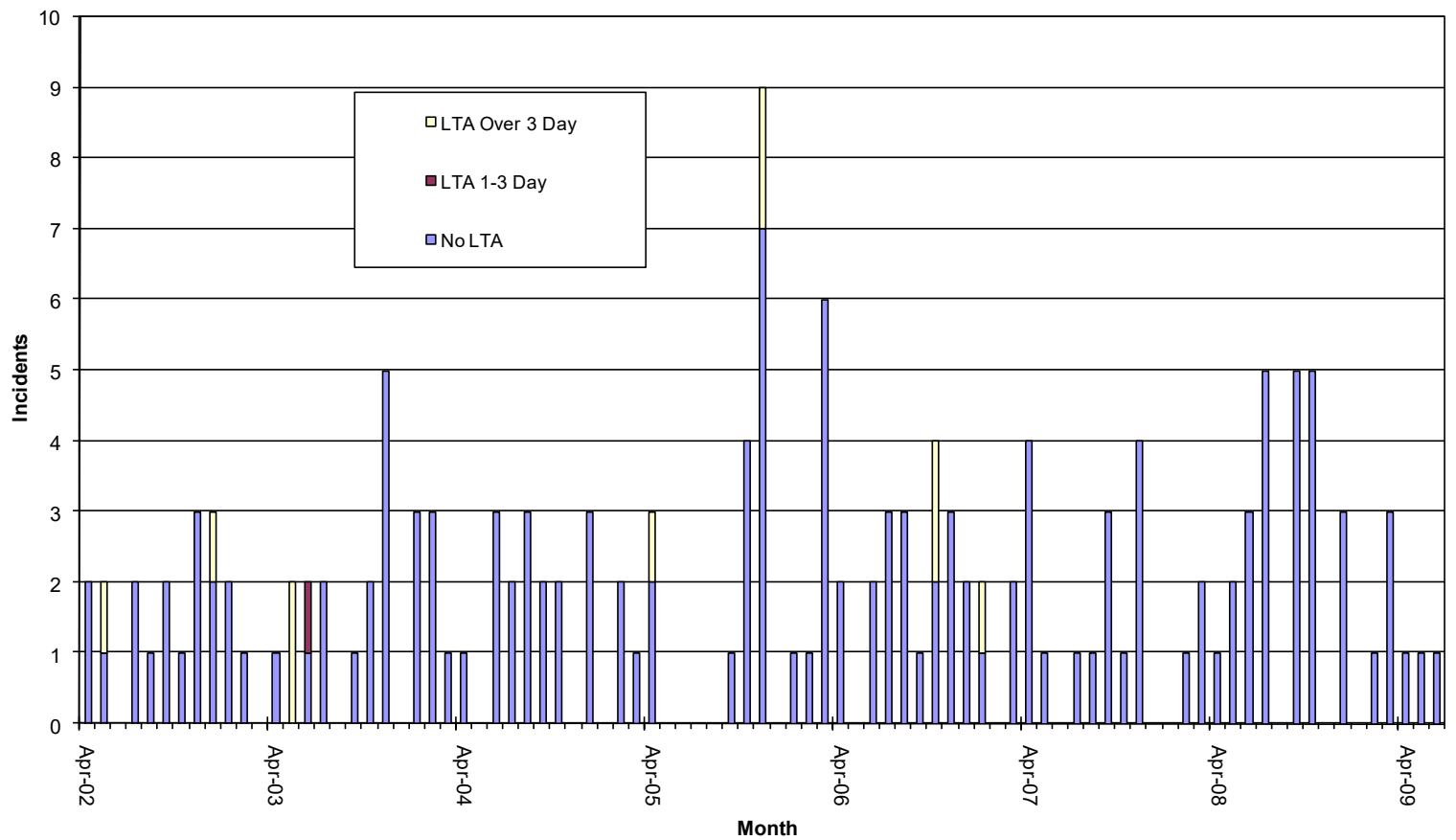
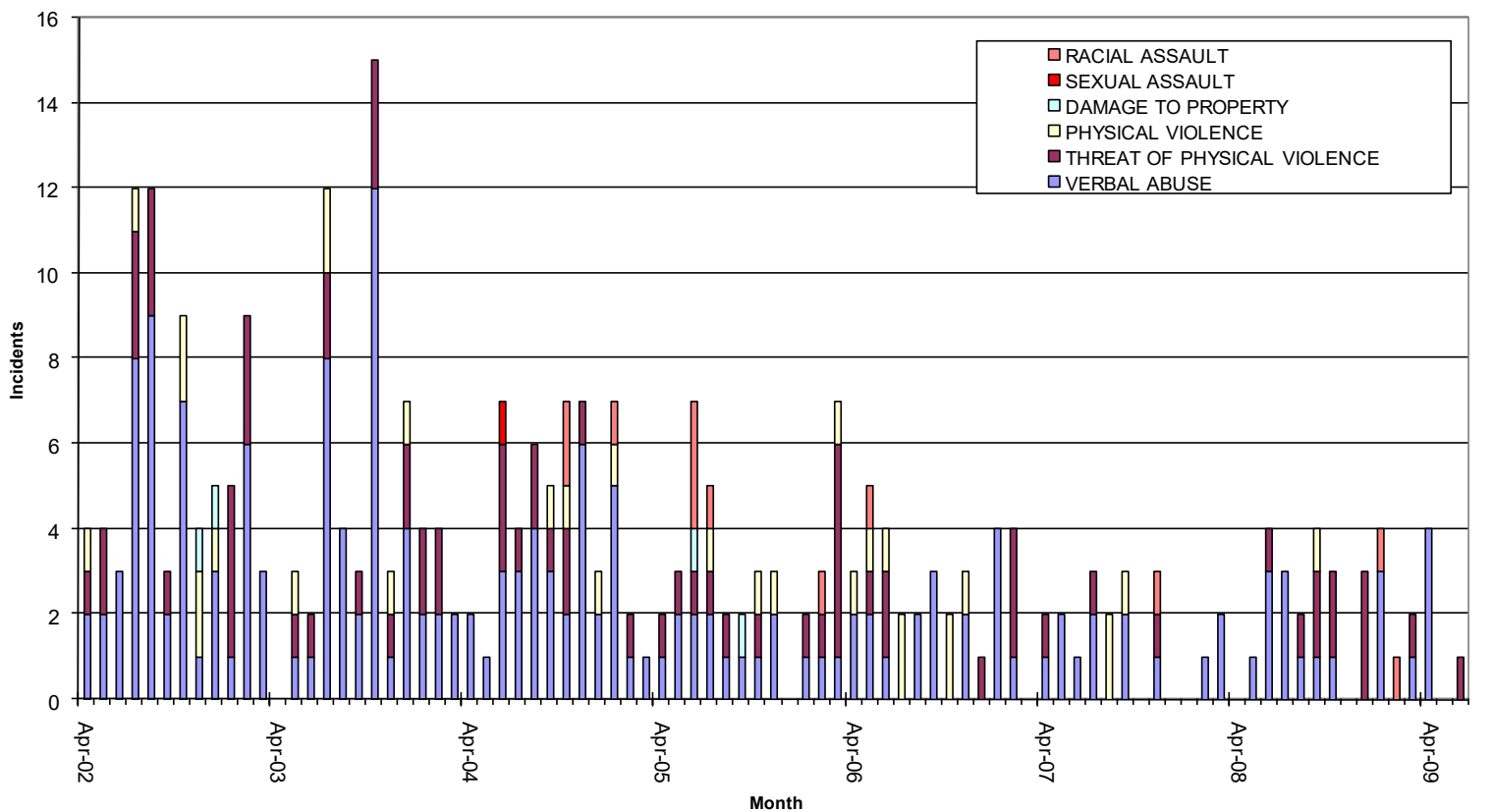

WARNING INDICATORS: When a warning indicator is placed on the housing management system it will be subject to review. All warnings will stay on for a minimum of six months and are then reviewed twice per year. For minor cases, If there have been no further incidents the warning will be removed.

25/06/09	<p>A member of the Family Intervention Project (FIP) went to visit a client family and accompany one of the children to the cinema. The mother was drunk and abusive and despite the attempts of other family members her behaviour and threats became worse.</p> <p>The incident spread into the street and the police were called. The police who are familiar with the client, tried to calm her down but she attacked the police van. She was then arrested for drunk and disorderly.</p>	The services of the FIP team have been withdrawn and the family informed.
