




Derby Homes - Summary of Requests for Quarter 4 (Appendix 2)

The below data is a summary of the requests sent from Derby Homes to the PPO team for investigation and feedback.

The requests are varied in nature but important to highlight what the team has achieved between the period of 01/01/23 to 31/03/23.



The total value indicates the number of visits or reports made by each categorised response.

Fly Tipping – Eleven reports have been made from Derby Homes to the PPO Team to investigate and pursue liability. Out of these eleven, three were issued with an FPN which is highlighted in the table below. The other eight, either had no evidence to pursue, no admission or the waste was no longer there on arrival.

Anti-Social Behaviour – The PPO Team attended six reports of anti-social behaviour made from Derby Homes. Subsequently out of these reports some of the locations are now on a hotspot priority list. Which involves weekly patrols with a view to challenging any anti-social behaviour.

Littering Issues – Three littering issues were attended by PPO's. With two instances being issued with an FPN as a result.

Obstruction in the Public Domain – Two Reports of Obstruction were attended. In one of these instances, the PPO officer attending is currently looking into issuing a CPNW for causing an obstruction in the public domain with assistance from Police SNT.

Request to Assist (Internal Departments) – Two assistance requests were carried out. A safe and well check for a complex need's resident at risk. Noted for patrols to increase to provide high visibility and re-assurance.





Homelessness – Two reports of known nominals at key begging locations in the city. Hotspot updated for both areas and patrols increased to identify and progress further with the REST team.

Parking Issues – One parking issue was reported in and attended by the team for a Caravan parking inconsiderately. However, on arrival PPO attending reported no issues have been caused

Drug Paraphernalia – One report of suspected Drug Paraphernalia was investigated. That a drying area was being used for drug and alcohol use as well as for rough sleeping, causing distress to residents. PPO confirmed area was unsecured and noted items used for drug use. Intel fed back to Derby Homes.


Vulnerable Person Assistance – One request to assist Derby Homes officer in delivering Door and Window alarms to a VP who greatly appreciated the joint visit

Noise Nuisance Reports – One noise nuisance report of a resident banging on the walls, harassing neighbours. PPO Officer reported this was a back-and-forth situation between the two parties and mediated negotiations to resolve it peacefully.

ABV's – One instance of an Abandoned Vehicle was investigated but PPO attending reported the ABV was no longer there and will be checking up periodically to see if it crops up again

Derby Homes Data – ASB

A total of 158 hotspot patrols were carried out during the period of 01/01/23 - 31/03/23. The below chart identifies the number of patrols per ward. The frequency of the patrols varies depending on the localised issue, they can range from daily/weekly/fortnightly etc. The level of patrols is adapted depending upon the requests and findings on the first couple of visits.





The following streets were patrolled on multiple occasions to conduct more in-depth investigations by the PPO team between 01/01/23 - 31/03/23, with the relevant information and intelligence relayed back.

A total of 3 separate locations.
