PERFORMANCE MONITORING

Report of the Director of Derby Homes

SUMMARY OF REPORT

1. To report to Committee up to date performance information of Derby Homes against key performance indicators relevant to the Committee's terms of reference.

RECOMMENDATIONS

MATTER FOR CONSIDERATION

- 3.1 A schedule of Performance Indicators has been constructed comprising
 - Housing management related Best Value Performance Indicators
 - Housing management set locally by the Council
 - Housing management Performance Indicators set locally by Derby Homes the Top Ten Targets'.
- 3.2 A monthly reporting cycle will enable the Committee to monitor performance and discuss the reasons for either over or under performance.
- Performance in the percentage of invoices paid in 30 days has improved in February to 83.72% and has shown a substantial improvement from the first quarter figure of 58.3%.
- 3.4 The percentage of rent collected as a % of rent due has improved each month and stood at 97.23% at the end of February.

 Performance against 51 Performance Indicators is regularly discussed with the City Council Monitoring Officer and local performance is reported to all community panels by local managers.
