1. SUMMARY OF REPORT

To inform the Board of some changes to the Local Government Pension Scheme.

2. **RECOMMENDATION**

To agree to the changes for transfer-in as detailed in this report.

3. MATTER FOR CONSIDERATION

- 3.1 Derbyshire County Council has changed its policy on the management of transfers-in from 1/10/2010. The Pensions Committee has recommended all Scheme Employers also adopt the revised policy.
- 3.2 Derby Homes has been requested to adopt this Policy. The changes will mean that any new employee who commences employment with a private pension will not be able to transfer that pension to the Local Government Scheme.
- 3.3 In addition any employee who joins us and is already in the Local Government Pension Scheme will have up to 12 months to opt to join the Derby Homes Scheme.
