3. Description of work(s)	<p>Conversion and use of a double decker Arriva bus as a mobile community centre “Neighbourhood Bus” for out reach work across Derby for use by Neighbourhood Boards, public sector and business partners for their community agendas.</p> <p>The bus itself is free from Arriva but £25k is required for refurbishment costs, including the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put partner logos on the bus • The bottom deck kitted out as an advice centre • The top middle deck with seating and tables • Front top as snack bar • Back top as a theatre with LCD screen • A canopy that can be attached to the side of the bus to provide shelter. 	
4. Why is the work needed?	<p>Areas in city that lack adequate provision or facilities</p> <p>The idea is that the bus will be a mobile facility that will proactively put on a range of events and carry out outreach work across Derby, related to community objectives of individual wards and partners. The partners include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enthusiasm (Lead partner) • Community Safety Partnership • Derby City Youth Service • Derbyshire Police Constabulary • Derbyshire Fire Service • NHS Derby City PCT 	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Connexions • Rolls Royce • Bombardier • British Army <p>Enthusiasm as a charity youth organisation will be the lead partner in that they will take ownership of the bus and provide staff. At this stage we are looking at refurbishment costs but a business plan is currently being devised to incorporate the future sustainability of the project.</p>
