

## **PETITION FROM THE RESIDENTS OF CASTLE HOUSE**

Report of the Director of Housing and Customer Service

### **1. SUMMARY**

A petition was received on the 13 May 2011 at the Stockbrook Street Office from 18 residents in Castle House requesting that the Vehicle Control Services ( VCS ) Car Parking Scheme be removed. An acknowledgement letter was sent to the lead petitioner.

### **2. RECOMMENDATION**

That the City Board notes the report and action taken by the Stockbrook Street Housing and Neighbourhood Manager to resolve the issue.

### **3. MATTER FOR CONSIDERATION**

- 3.1 The parking scheme at Castle House was introduced eight years ago at the request of residents. Residents were unable to park because rail commuters were taking up the car parking spaces.
- 3.2 The Housing and Neighbourhood Manager advised the lead petitioner that she would consult all residents to ensure they were aware of the implications of removing the parking permit scheme. Although letters have been sent to all 24 residents, to date only 3 have replied that they want the parking scheme removing
- 3.3 Each resident will receive a home visit in an attempt to improve consultation results before a decision is reached. The lead petitioner is being kept informed of progress.
