BUSINESS TRANSFORMATION UPDATE

Report of the Director & Company Secretary

1. SUMMARY

This report updates the Committee on the Business Transformation programme.

2. **RECOMMENDATION**

To note the successful implementation of the Business Transformation programme and to note that the outcome is well ahead of target, generating short term surpluses.

3. MATTER FOR CONSIDERATION

- 3.1 The Business Transformation programme has now achieved a total saving of £1.9m against the four year target of £2.2m. Plans are in place to deliver the remainder of the target, and the whole target should be reached by 2013, which would be a year ahead of target.
- 3.2 The speed at which the savings have been delivered well ahead of target means that Derby Homes is currently underspending and building up reserves. The use of those reserves will be discussed as part of the budget setting process.

Analysis and Information

3.3 The savings achieved to date and in the future can be summarised as follows:

- 3.4 As can be seen, both areas are well ahead of their individual targets and will remain so. In effect there are now plans in place to overachieve even the stretched targets that we set ourselves to deliver efficiencies.
- 3.5 In effect the Business Transformation process has been completed. That is not to say that further efficiency cannot be achieved and even better service delivered, and Derby Homes will continue to strive for this in the future. The aim of improving service and efficiency is now well embedded and further efficiency opportunities will be taken when they are required or are available. The resources released will be reconsidered for further investment in Derby Homes and Council housing priorities.
- 3.6 Much of the additional resource generated by being ahead of target has resulted in increased Derby Home' reserves. These will be considered at the Budget scrutiny day and plans drawn up for further investment by Derby Homes.
- 3.7 The current budget process for 2013/14 will also be discussed in detail, including the impact of welfare reform, supporting people funding losses and other pressures on the current budget.

4. FINANCIAL AND BUSINESS PLAN IMPLICATIONS

The financial impacts are that the savings required have been generated ahead of schedule, increasing Derby Homes' reserves in the short term, and enabling a more proactive use of such resources to generate further savings where possible and to invest in other priorities agreed with the Council, perhaps including new homes exempt from the Right to Buy.

5. **RISK IMPLICATIONS**

Failure to deliver the business transformation programme is on the risk register and can now be regarded as fully mitigated.
