PROFESSIONAL AND CONSULTANCY FEES 2011/12

Report of the Director & Company Secretary

1. SUMMARY

This report summarises the expenditure on legal, professional and consultancy services during 2011/12. It also explains the process for the selection of consultants.

2. **RECOMMENDATION**

- 2.1 To note the contents of the report.
- 2.2 To approve the continued submission of this report to the Committee on an annual basis.
- 2.3 To approve the process for selecting legal, professional and consultancy services as detailed in 3.3.

3. MATTER FOR CONSIDERATION

- 3.1 Expenditure on legal, professional and consultancy services during 2011/12 was £226,000 (2010/11 £594,000). This is shown in more detail within Section 4.
- 3.2 The Resources, Remuneration and Regeneration Committee on 8 July 2010 resolved that annual updates on this area of spend is to be made to the Committee. The Committee is asked to consider that this is continued.
- 3.3 There is no change to the process for selecting consulting services that was reported to the Committee on 7 July 2011. The key process is that the Executive Team approves the appointment in line with existing procurement procedures unless a waiver is required.

4. FINANCIAL AND BUSINESS PLAN IMPLICATIONS

4.1 In 2011/12 total spend on legal, professional and consulting services was £226,000; details on suppliers above £5,000 are shown below:

 - £154,000 NCC Services Ltd for project management work on Academy/Meridio
 - £78,000 Just Housing Ltd on consultancy work for the DLO transfer
 - £105,000 Anthony Collins Solicitors for legal advice on the DLO transfer and DLO employment issues
 - £43,000 Derby City Council on general legal advice.
