1. SUMMARY

This report updates the City Board on Quick Fix bids which have been approved.

3. MATTER FOR CONSIDERATION

- 3.1 Derby Homes, through the Capital Funding Programme, allocates £300k, divided equally to the five locally managed areas. The work mainly focuses on environmental improvements & community safety. The projects involve local people in the decision making on how and where the fund is spent in their area.
- 3.2 Details of the approved Quick Fix bids, an update of current bids and a financial breakdown are appended to this report.

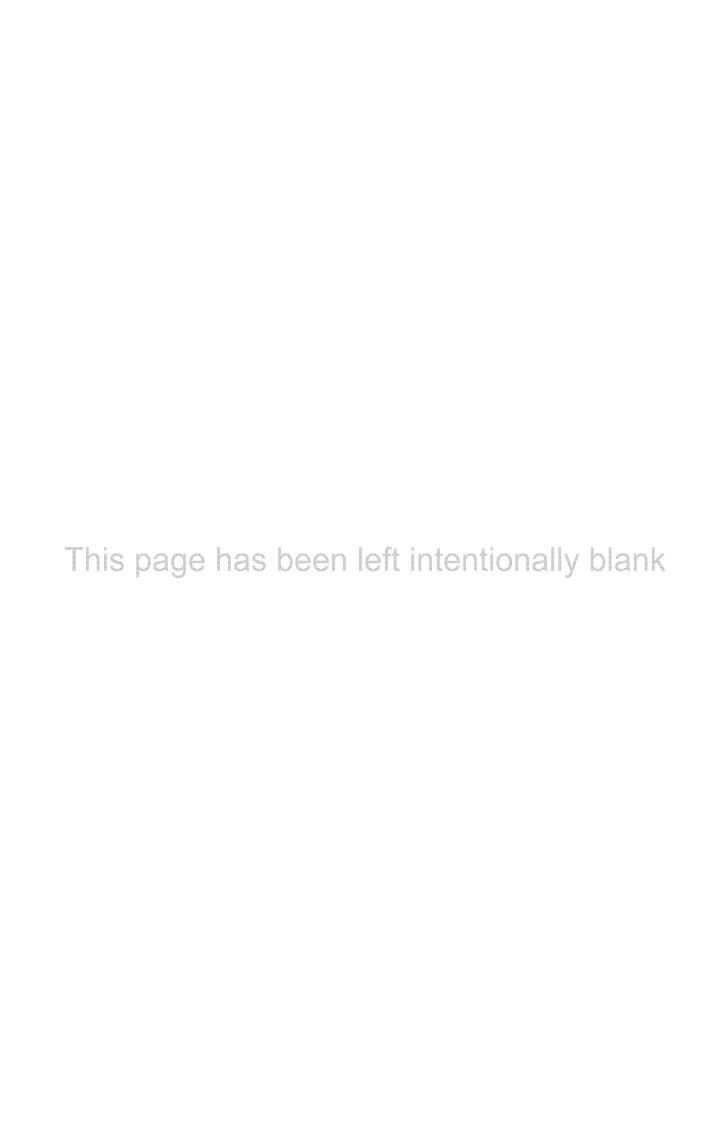
