#### 3. MATTER FOR CONSIDERATION

- 3.1 The DACP Partnership Forum is a project owned by the Derby Association of Community Partners Ltd. The Customer Engagement & Community Development Team facilitates the Forum.
- 3.2 The first meeting of the new Partnership Forum took place on 11th August 2015 and has met a total of 4 times. The Forum meets quarterly.
- 3.3 The purpose of the Forum is to; act as a representative body for all Derby Homes' Community Partners act as an initial/single point of reference for Derby Homes and other statutory and non-statutory agencies; act as an initial/single point of reference for customers in receipt of services delivered by partners of Derby Homes
- 3.4 Forum membership is open to representatives of all Derby Homes partners including:
  - Contractors
  - Voluntary Organisations
  - Constituted Groups (for example Scouting/Guide Groups, Sports Clubs, Tenant And Resident Associations, Neighbourhood Watch Schemes)
  - Local Non-Constituted, but organised Groups (for example Library Reading Groups, Craft Groups)
  - Charities
  - Community Interest Companies & Social Enterprises
  - Faith Groups

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- 3.5 The role of the representative(s) at these meetings is to:
  - ensure relevant information from the organisation they represent is made available to the DACP Forum;
  - ensure relevant information from the DACP Forum is communicated back to their organisation;
  - ensure their organisations interests and perspectives are represented in discussions, decision making, and consultations; observing where appropriate 'conflicts of interest'.
- 3.6 The meeting format is working well with attendees reporting positive outcomes for themselves and their representative organisations afforded by the opportunity to network and share best practice and ideas.
- 3.7 The members themselves are now reviewing the Partnership Agreement with a view to them reshaping this document to afford greater value from the information this holds, evidencing the genuine buy-in by members of the new Forum.
- 3.8 It is anticipated the new Partnership Agreement will be finalised and agreed at the next meeting; coupled with the efficiency of the meeting format, this presents as a successful first year development for the Forum.
