3. MATTER FOR CONSIDERATION

3.1 ACCIDENT AND INCIDENT REPORTS

Accidents and incidents involving Derby Homes' staff are recorded using a formal reporting system. In September and October there were 3 reported accidents. One of these was a Lost Time Accident (LTA) but not reportable as less than 3 days absence resulted. More details are shown in the attached accident and incident trends chart (Appendix 1).

3.2 VIOLENCE AND AGGRESSION REPORTS

Violent, aggressive or abusive incidents towards staff are reported by staff using a formal reporting system. Appropriate action is always taken against the perpetrator. In September and October there was one reported case of violence, aggression or abuse towards staff. More details are shown in the attached violence and aggression trends chart (Appendix 1).
