## INTRODUCTION TO THE PARTNERSHIP REGISTER

<i>The partnership with Working Links has improved the level of service provided to Tenancy sustainment service-users. When a service-user meets the criteria of Working Links, a referral is made and a joint visit arranged with the relevant area based officer. A service plan is then discussed to outline a joint working programme between both officers. The partnership ensures that each service-user receives a more rounded &amp; in-depth service which meets all of their vulnerability needs. It also helps to achieve the primary aim of introductory tenant sustaining their tenancies. In a co-ordinated approach, the TSO concentrates on the intensive housing management roles such as; working around welfare reforms, maximising income, sorting out benefit claims, debt &amp; budgeting advice, obtaining furniture, chasing up repairs etc – the Working links officer focuses more around social inclusion, family support &amp; finding employment.</i>
