This also brought ourselves into contact to support a number of groups by bringing them into the centre also, including dedicated active dads, Sinfin family action network, Winchester club, umbrella, IMPACT derby formerly known as gangs advisory service, and local schools.

Additional projects launched from the partnership include the Sinfin community exchange – which dh has provided the project plan for, and also the celebrating Sinfin and Osmaston week initiatives.

DH is a founding funder of the provision of Rent Payment Accounts (RPA) to tenants in Derby provided by Erewash CU under the umbrella of the EMCU. This umbrella group is funded by 30 of RSLs in the Region. The RPA helps us to collect the rent under the new Welfare Reform regime and the introduction of Universal Credit.

The RPA helps us to enable tenants to join a credit union and this will enable them to access safe and low cost credit (helping to prevent them using loan sharks and expensive on-line lenders) and also enable them to access savings accounts that will contribute to them building up their own financial capability. The transaction costs for the RPA are met from the HRA as part of the rent collection costs going forward.
