
As a result of the doorstep campaigns we created 10 new Customer Priorities based on issues raised which will run to the end of 2017.

The Customer Survey continues to be completed with tenants on a face to face and telephone basis.


#### **RESULTS**

is less than happy with the lack of parking facilities near bungalow and that has been tackled for parking on the grass area at the front of the property, says only parks there to unload shopping of if has an item that is too heavy to carry. This is obviously a topic that really affects and would even consider moving out of the area.

only issues are tenant needs two repairs for next week re-arranging to avoid school runs - agreed to contact CST 31.03.17 to do this for her. also tenant states tenant has a mud patch outside rear door and concerned it might be a drainage issue - reported to CST to raise repair 31.03.17

Our repairs workforce are letting the side down.

Recently rang Derby Homes about trimming an overgrown hedge on a communal piece of land which wasnt being done so she contacted CIIr Banwait. It has now been done but the person tenant spoke to initially wasn't helpful.

Staff are very helpful, everything is very useful with the information we are provided by Derby Homes.

struggled to complete survey with tenant as said does not have much to do with Derby Homes. Latest involvement was when tenant had to report smell of cannabis in the block and dealt with ASB Officer, tenant didn't know what expected him to do but didn't feel heard, found him quite sharp when he spoke to tenant. I spoke at length to tenant about cannabis and what DH can or cannot do. Advised tenant to report it to crime stoppers as they pass info anonymously to the police, tenant is going to share this with neighbours. by end of call tenant was satisfied with Derby Homes but unable to complete much of the survey withtenant as mostly wanted to discuss the ASB issues tenant was having.

Thank you for all the help Derby Homes has given me

the area has gone down rapidly due to teenagers, drug dealing and taking and alcohol.

The bathroom sliding door does not have a runner on the bottom of it. As we are getting older the door seems to swing out a bit. We were told we'd be having a new door but nothing has come of it yet.

The complex has deteriorated since removal of the warden controlled scheme. This is why a number of tenants are leaving Donington Close and the new tenants who have replaced them have changed the dynamics of the scheme.

There are beer bottles and cans on the green area - this is from people come home after the Paddock Pub is closed. Tnt feels that when he reports a repair it doesn't get done, for example F/E lock was reported 5 times as tnt was unable to lock door. Contractors have been out, glued the door, Surveyor has been out, tnt has been told that door will get replaced within 3 years and tnt is still waiting, feels this is very poor service.

There have been five new bungalows built at the end of the row of our flats. The wall has been taken down and our drying area has gone. We need two new rotary driers, the area tidying, making level and for us to be able to use it again for our sheets and towels etc.

To see Holly Court community room used more. Takes a while for CST to answer phone.

Tree requires cutting on communal land. Too big and branches falling off that could cause damage to cars / properties / residents.

very happy with the service whenever we come in




