A monitoring meeting has been arranged for 31.5.12.
2	Sporting Futures	18 months community sports delivery to the young people in Old and New Sinfin. Two sessions are held every week for the duration of 1.5 hours on Friday evening and 2 hours on Saturday lunchtime. A monitoring meeting has been arranged for 19.7.12. Details of the sessions are on the Derby Homes website.
3	Climbing wall	Managers are booking their allocated climbing wall sessions. A climbing wall timetable is on Derby Homes' website.
